CALL FOR PAPERS

Jurnal Ekonomi Kesehatan Indonesia (EKI), presents scientific writings on information and updates of health economic in collaboration with Centre for Health Economic and Policy Studies (CHEPS) Universitas Indonesia and INAHEA (Indonesian Health Economic Association). Jurnal EKI had been published two times (two number) annually (per volume) in two languages (Bahasa Indonesia and English) electronically and printed. It includes research findings, case studies, and conceptual fields, namely: health economic, health insurance, health administration/policy, pharmaco-economic, and Health Technology Assessment (HTA). However, In order to ensure the quality of Journal EKI, the editorial board members have decided to publish twice a year since 2018.

AUTHOR GUIDELINES

COMPONENT MANUSCRIPT

Manuscripts should be sent in Microsoft Word or Open Office in accordance to article structure mentioned above, written in Times New Roman in font size of 12, 1.5 spaced, 1 inch (2.54 cm) for all margin and not more than 3000 words (not including tables, figures and references). Page number is started from the cover page.

ABSTRACT

Abstract is written in both Bahasa Indonesia and English in 100-200 words. It should be a comprehensive paragraph including background, study objectives, methods, result, discussion, and conclusion along with 3-5 keywords. There should not be any citations in this section.

TITLE OF THE MANUSCRIPT

Title, full names, affiliation and addresses of all authors including full postal address, telephone and fax, and email addresses. Suggestions for a short running title of no more than 15 characters. Acknowledgements of financial or research assistance, places where the manuscript has been presented, thanks to discussants, and so on; these must be placed on the Title Page and should not appear anywhere else in the manuscript.

MANUSCRIPT STRUCTURE

Manuscripts should be prepared as follows: titles and abstracts in both Bahasa Indonesia and English, authorships; Keywords; Introduction; Methods; Result; Discussion; Conclusion; and Reference List as described.

- **Introduction** includes background, brief literature review, gap analysis and study objectives
- **Methods** include study design, selected population, sample size, data source, data collection and analysis procedure
- **Results** contain concise and clear paragraphs of findings without authors' perspectives/opinion. Consist of no more than 6 tables or figures that are written in single space and numbered.
- **Discussion** should explore significance of the findings, instead of repeating them. It should contain relevant comparison with previous theories and studies without extensive citations.
- **Conclusion** and suggestions (if applicable) should answer the objectives of the study without exceeding the findings. Suggestions should perfectly align with study objectives and conclusion.

REFERENCES

References should be prepared using Harvard styles. Please use Reference Manage Applications like EndNote, Mendeley, Zotero, etc. Cite only scientific publications that you read and current journal references. The minimum number of references is 15 pieces of literature, and 80% come from the latest sources (maximum of the last ten years).
